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EXPLANATION:

The FY14 Forsyth County Budget anticipates a transfer of \$1,735,000 from the General Fund to the 2012 WS/FC Schools 2/3rds Capital Maintenance Capital Projects Ordinance (CPO). This CPO was established for life cycle replacements to school facilities including, but not limited to chillers, roof replacements, and HVAC repairs.

This CPO amendment transfers \$1,735,000 from the General Fund to the CPO. Once this transfer is completed, the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Schools to begin work on the projects identified on the Amendment to the 2012 WS/FC Schools 2/3rds Capital Maintenance CPO at various schools.
