1. Registered Voter
2. Twenty-one (21) years of age; NC Const., Art. VI, sec. 6 (Exceptions - 25 years of age - State Senate; NC Const., Art. II, Sec. 6).
3. Affiliated with political party for 90 days by date of filing Notice of Candidacy (i.e. if filing on last day of filing period, party affiliation must have been changed by December 1, 2011, NCGS 163-106 (b).
4. Residency Requirement (State Senate - 2 years in State, 1 year in district, NC Const., Art. II, Sec. 6); (State House, 1 year in district, NC Const., Art. II, Sec. 7); County Commissioner and Superior Court Judges must reside in the district; Congress - NC resident, residence not required in the district.
*The filing fee is calculated by one percent of the annual starting salary of the office.
