#### PUNCH CARD BALLOT INSTRUCTIONS

- (a) To vote for all candidates of one party (a straight ticket), punch the card at the right of the party for whose candidates you wish to vote.
- (b) You may vote a split ticket by punching the card beside the name of a candidate of a different party. In any multi-seat race where a straight party is punched, and you vote for candidates of another party, in order for your vote to count for any candidates for that office of the party for which you voted straight party, you must punch opposite the name of those candidates.
- (c) You may also vote a split ticket by not making a punch for the party, but by punching beside the name of each candidate for whom you wish to vote.
- (d) If you tear or deface or wrongly punch your ballot card, return it and get another.

**A STRAIGHT PARTY PUNCH DOES NOT CAST A VOTE FOR THE PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATE OF THAT PARTY OR FOR A NON-PARTISAN RACE OR FOR BONDS.**
